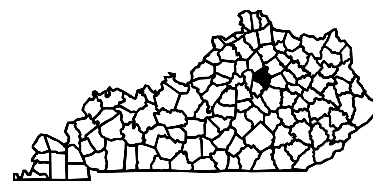

Application deadlines: Early Action: December 1
Regular: February 15

Students should apply by the December 1 Early Action application deadline to be considered for academic and competitive scholarships or the Lewis Honors College.
